We offer specialised therapeutic horse riding through a range of programmes for people living with physical, intellectual, emotional and social challenges. Our focus is to make a positive difference and change lives.

ENTITY STRUCTURE

Group Structure

Riding for the Disabled Association Manawatu Group Incorporated has a total of eight Committee Members that constitute the governance board. In accordance with our constitution, three Executive Office positions: President, Secretary/Treasurer and Vice President have been appointed and constitute the Executive Committee.

Operation Structure

Our operations are managed by a team of forty one volunteers, these include Duty Coaches, Privacy & Vunerable Children Officers, Safety Officer, Volunteer Coordinator and Horse Committee. Monthly reports are presented to the Governance Committee. Additional volunteers support the group with our various fundraising activities throughout the year.

MAIN SOURCES OF THE ENTITY'S CASH AND RESOURCES

Riding for the Disabled Association Manawatu Group Incorporated has received its income from a mixture of donations, fundraising and the use of the indoor riding arena.

FUNDRAISING

Fundraising activites includes hiring arena for special events, coaching courses, and requests to service clubs for sponsorship of riders.

RELIANCE

Volunteers oversee both the governance and operation functions of the Group. The Group has one paid staff member for paddock management. Donated goods are received on occasions e.g. Horses, tack and covers.

RDA riding programmes are used to develop, increase and improve physical, psychological, social and recreation/sport/vocational abilities, with the following fields:

OTHER INFORMATION

During our Covid-19 break, considerable infrastructure improvements were undertaken in the arena. The ramp was extended. The arena offside area was fenced, the bark removed and Lime laid. The waiting room was partially concreted.

The arena surface is regarded as one of the best surfaces in the country.

When the Government announced the impending Covid-19 Lockdown, Manawatu Riding for the Disabled ceased operations and riding on 20 March 2020. During Lockdown 4 only one person was attending RDA to care for the horses. Once level two was introduced, most activities resumed with appropriate safety measures in place, ie Arena Hire. At that stage we did not have have the riders themselves.

The children returned for an introduction day, without riding, on the 15 October 2020. Riding sessions for children resumed on 22 October 2020 and continued until Christmas break on 11 December 2020.

NOTES TO THE PERFORMANCE REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2020

1 STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

REPORTING ENTITY

Riding for the Disabled Association Manawatu Group Incorporated is domiciled in New Zealand and is a charitable organisation registered under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908.

BASIS OF PREPARATION

Riding for the Disabled Association Manawatu Group Incorporated has elected to apply Public Benefit Entity Simple Format Reporting - Accrual (Not-for-Profit) (PBE SFR-A (NFP)), as established by the External Reporting Board for registered charities, on the basis that it does not have public accountability and has total annual expenses of equal to or less than \$2,000,000 for the last two annual reporting periods. All transactions in the Performance Report are reported using the accrual basis of accounting. The Performance Report is prepared under the assumption that the Society will continue to operate as a going concern in the foreseeable future.

SPECIFIC ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The following is a summary of the significant accounting policies adopted by the Society in the preparation of this Performance Report.

Bank Accounts and Cash

Bank and Cash in the Statement of Cash Flows comprise of cash balances and bank balances (including short term deposits) with original maturities of 90 days or less.

Accounts Receivable

Accounts receivable are stated at their estimated realisable value.

Property, Plant, Equipment and Depreciation

Property, plant and equipment are recorded at cost less aggregate depreciation provided at the maximum rates allowed by the Inland Revenue Department. The depreciation rates used are shown in the Schedule of Property, Plant and Equipment.

Investments

Investments are stated at cost.

Grants

Grants received are included in operating revenue. If particular conditions are attached to a grant that would require it to be repaid if these conditions are not met, then the grant is recorded as a liability until the conditions are satisfied.

Donations

Donations received are included in operating revenue. If particular conditions are attached to a donation that would require it to be repaid if these conditions are not met, then the donation is recorded as a liability until the conditions are satisfied.

Donated goods or services (other than donated assets) are not recognised.

Where significant donated assets are received with useful lives of 12 months or more, and the fair value of the asset is readily obtainable, the donation is recorded at the value of the asset obtained. Where the fair value of the asset is not readily obtainable, the donation is not recorded. Donated assets with useful lives less than 12 months are not recorded.

NOTES TO THE PERFORMANCE REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2020

Goods and Services Tax

Financial information in this performance report is recorded exclusive of GST with the exception of receivables and payables, which include GST. GST payable or receivable at balance date is included in the appropriate category in the Statement of Financial Position.

Tax Status

The Group has been granted Charitable Status under Section CW41 of the Income Tax Act 2007 therefore is exempt from Income Tax.

Cinnamon, Dot, Rosie, Lily, Chloe, Pally and Jordee.

Horses

There has been a change in policy regarding the valuation of horses, horses are to be capitalised and no longer expensed when purchased. Valuation will be at actual cost.

Changes in Accounting Policies

There has been a change in accounting policy during the year. Horses puchased are no longer expensed and shown as an asset in the Statement of Financial Position.
